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HOW YOUR CONTRIBUTION WORKS IN YOUR COMMUNITY

Research: The American Lung Association of Washington funds both national and local research to find the causes and cures of lung disease. Locally, grants are awarded in supporting research directed toward our program goals related to asthma, the impact of air pollution on lung health and smoking among youth.

Advocacy: We work to eliminate smoking in all public places in Washington state, to challenge amendments to the Clean Air Act, to ensure air quality protects the health of those with respiratory diseases, and maintain funding for public health. In 2003, the legislature approved funding for 5,000 school buses to be retrofitted to reduce diesel exhaust fumes. In 2004, along with other health advocates, we will push the legislature to ban smoking in all indoor public places.

Education: Today, 55 youth in Washington state became life long smokers. Our Teens Against Tobacco Use program trains youth facilitators statewide to educate more than 20,000 middle and elementary students each year about the hazards of tobacco use. One in six households in Washinton state has someone with asthma. Our Master Home Environmentalist program teaches volunteers to perform free indoor air quality home assessments to benefit those households. Asthma is an emergency and is the number one reason for school absenteeism. Our asthma management programs help manage a child's asthma through education.
